Eight women formed GFWC Woman's Club of Lakeside in 1910. Their mission was mutual helpfulness and sociability, the cultivation of interest in intellectual and civic pursuit for Lakeside. The red geranium was to be the club flower; red and green were chosen for the club colors.

Over the past 107 years, the club has successfully continued these goals with the distinction of being the first and oldest community service organization in Lakeside. A few of the events in the history of the Woman's Club of Lakeside include:

- Assisting with the building of the Lakeside Town Hall in 1911
- Establishing a branch of the county library in 1913
